


# END TIMES SURVIVAL GUIDE



## *Preparedness Action Plan*

Start securing these items today to complete your preparedness action plan within only one month.

**Step 1:** Secure your Bible.

**Step 2:** Assess emergency food supply of non-perishable food items. Take inventory of what you have on hand & what your family needs. Expand as needed.

**Step 3:** Identify water sources (bottled water, stored water, water filter, canteens, and collapsible water carriers, water purifying mobile kit, water purifying tablets). This is most important.

**Step 4:** Have cash on hand. Some people recommend a limited amount of large bills for easy storage. Others recommend small bills.

**Step 5:** Assemble a first-aid kit (more than Band-Aids).

**Step 6:** Store extra medicine (as required) - aspirin, allergy medicine, pain pills, hydrocortisone cream for insect bites, Neosporin, etc.

**Step 7:** Determine need for protective/weather appropriate clothing (water resistant, for warmth, for sun protection; underwear, rubberized boots or shoes, jacket, shirt, pants, socks, cap, hat or scarf, raincoat or poncho, foldable umbrella, etc.

**Step 8:** Have a fire extinguisher on hand.

**Step 9:** Install fire alarms.

**Step 10:** Install carbon monoxide alarms.

**Step 11:** Locate a portable radio (a weather band combination battery/hand crank radio does not require batteries).

**Step 12:** Identify alternate power source (generator, solar chargers, batteries).

**Step 13:** Identify alternate heat source (blankets, hand warmers, fireplaces).

**Step 14:** Gather fire starters (matches, lighters)

**Step 15:** Consider alternate ways of communication (whistle, landline telephone, cell phone, text, internet access, two-way radio, ink pen and paper, forever stamps).

**Step 16:** Create a contact list (in-state and out-of-state). Back up phone numbers in an address book. Include numbers for out-of-town relatives.

**Step 17:** Buy batteries (variety).

- Step 18:** Create hygiene kit (toothpaste, toothbrush, comb, deodorant, soap, hand towel, feminine products, Vaseline, alcohol, toilet tissue, sunscreen, ChapStick, hand sanitizer, isopropyl alcohol, bleach, iodine).
- Step 19:** Evaluate need for a sanitation kit (toilet paper, portable toilet).
- Step 20:** Store important documents and photos on USB drive.
- Step 21:** Gather cooking implements and aluminum food utensils (manual can opener, knives, portable stove, sun oven, pots, dishes, forks, spoons).
- Step 22:** Identify fuel needs for cooking and other (propane, butane, BBQ, matches in waterproof container).
- Step 23:** Survey and/or acquire some camping equipment (tarps, tents, weather-resistant sleeping bags, blankets, backpacks, camping stoves).
- Step 24:** Determine alternate light source (flashlights, candles, head lamps, camping lanterns).
- Step 25:** Aggregate tools (shovel, saw, pick, wrench, wire cutters, rope, (screwdriver, pliers, small hammer, knife).
- Step 26:** Acquire regional maps and have a compass.
- Step 27:** Determine how to shut off utilities at home (water, electric, gas)
- Step 28:** Perform a home hazard hunt (identify risks at home and remediate).
- Step 29:** Keep gasoline tanks in vehicles full.
- Step 30:** Create a family emergency plan (how to evacuate, who to contact, how to communicate, meeting locations).
- Step 31:** Find out more about how to prepare in your area (flood zones, fault lines, etc.).

### ***Other Items to Consider***

1. Small caliber gun (if you have a state permit)
2. Eyeglasses and sunglasses
3. Drivers' license and/or other state ID
4. Cell phone and mobile charger
5. Duct tape or cord string
